



Days Out from Rosedale with Moorsbus

Saturdays, Sundays & Bank Holidays in July, August & September 2022

Moorsbus is a network of friendly, wheelchair accessible, public bus services to and through the North York Moors designed and operated by a not-for-profit Community Interest Company.

All day Moors Rover tickets are £9.50 (£2.50 child / young person 5 – 17).

Single fares from just £1. English National Concessionary Passes accepted.

Young persons' flat fare single journey ticket £1. Contactless payment usually available. The EY128 / X28 buses sell and accept Moors Rover £9.50 tickets.

In towns, Moorsbuses use existing bus stops. In country areas, give a clear signal to the driver to get on, and tell the driver in advance where you'd like to get off.

Here are some suggested days out from Rosedale Abbey.

SATURDAY Danby Moors Centre and Dalby Forest

Catch the M6 at 1009 from Rosedale to Danby, arriving at The Moors Centre at 1039 (exhibition, tea rooms, toilets, art gallery, information, shop, picnic sites, play area, trails – free admission). *You could stay here all day as there are several easy walks and trails, catching the direct M6 back to Rosedale at 1645 (arrives Rosedale at 1715).* If you want to visit Dalby Forest, you could leave Danby on M3 at 1200 to Pickering (arrive 1255) and then get the M7 at 1352 to Dalby Forest (arrive 1409). At Low Dalby you'll find the visitor centre, café, toilets, play areas and aerial activity at GoApe. The bus for Rosedale leaves Low Dalby at 1525, arriving at Rosedale Abbey at 1600.

SATURDAY Hutton le Hole

Get M6 at 1115 to Pickering (arrive 1139) and then catch the M3 from Pickering at 1200 to Hutton le Hole (arrive 1232). Tea rooms, pub, toilets and award-winning Ryedale Folk Museum set in a 6 acre site with reconstructed buildings from the Iron Age to the 1950s. At 1453 catch the M3 back to Danby (arrive 1525) and then the 1645 M6 to Rosedale Abbey (arrive 1715).

SATURDAY Pickering and Thornton le Dale

Leave Rosedale Abbey on M6 at 1115 arriving in Pickering at 1139. At 1352 catch the M7 to Thornton le Dale (arrive 1359). Pubs, tea rooms, shops, toilets, Car Museum (as featured in the TV series *'Bangers and Cash.'* Leave Thornton le Dale at 1535 on M7 to Pickering and on to Rosedale Abbey (arrive 1600).

SUNDAY & BANK HOLIDAY **Full day at Danby Moors Centre**

Catch the 1009 M6 to Danby (arrives 1039). (exhibition, tea rooms, toilets, art gallery, information, shop, picnic sites, play area, trails – free admission). Several easy walks around the area to keep you active (details at The Moors Centre). Leave Danby on M6 at 1645, arriving in Rosedale Abbey at 1715.

SUNDAY & BANK HOLIDAY **Danby and moorland journey to Kirkbymoorside**

Catch the 1009 M6 to Danby (arrives 1039). (exhibition, tea rooms, toilets, art gallery, information, shop, picnic sites, play area, trails – free admission). The M3 departs Danby at 1315 for Kirkbymoorside (arrive 1357) (shops, pubs, cafes, toilets). 128 departs Kirkbymoorside at 1445 to Pickering (arrive 1506) and then catch the M6 to Rosedale at 1545, arriving back at 1609.

SUNDAY & BANK HOLIDAY **Pickering and Helmsley**

Catch the M6 from Rosedale Abbey at 1115 arriving in Pickering at 1139. At 1245 get the 128 to Helmsley (arrives 1321). Shops, pubs, cafes, toilets, Castle, Birds of Prey Centre, Walled Garden. Return to Pickering on the 128 at 1430 (arrives Pickering 1506) and then catch the M6 to Rosedale at 1545, arriving back at 1609.

SUNDAY & BANK HOLIDAY **Dalby Forest and Thornton le Dale**

Catch the M6 from Rosedale Abbey at 1115 arriving in Pickering at 1139. Stay on the bus as it takes you to Thornton le Dale (1149) and Low Dalby Visitor Centre (1159). Café, toilets, trails, play areas, picnic sites, walks, trails and GoApe aerial activities. Catch the M7 at 1410 to Thornton le Dale (arrives 1420). Cafes, pub, toilets, ice creams, and Car Museum. Leave Thornton le Dale at 1535 for the through bus to Pickering and Rosedale (arrive Rosedale 1609). For a later departure from Dalby, leave Dalby at 1525 on the M7 back to Rosedale (arrive 1609).

SUNDAY & BANK HOLIDAY **Walk & Ride** – *check our website for these and other walk details*

Blakey Lion Inn, East Mines and Kilns to Rosedale Abbey (5.5 miles, allow 3 hours)

Rosedale depart 1009 to Ralph Cross (arr 1022), walk to Lion Inn and then via old railway line to East Mines and Rosedale Abbey.

Dalby Forest to Thornton le Dale (4 miles; 2 hours)

Rosedale depart 1115 to Low Dalby (arr 1159). Walk to Thornton le Dale. M7 to Pickering and Rosedale departs at 1410 and 1525.

Esk Valley Walks: Ralph Cross, Danby Dale to Castleton; Ralph Cross, Westerdale to Castleton; Castleton to Danby (varying length)

Depart Rosedale at 1009 to Ralph Cross (1022), Castleton (1030) or Danby (1039) (depending on walk). Direct bus back to Rosedale leaves Danby Moors Centre at 1645, Castleton (1654) and Ralph Cross (1702) getting back to Rosedale Abbey at 1715.

Similar walks can be enjoyed on a Saturday – just check the different timetable.

Always plan your walk with care. Take appropriate food, drink and clothing, a timetable – and a good map.
